In support of the training program at Blue Ridge CTC and to promote interest in electric utility work, UWUA Local 102 has made one \$2,500 scholarship available. To be considered for the scholarship the applicant must have successfully completed EDET 101: Intro to Linework and be enrolled as an EDET major and is pursuing an AAS Degree at Blue Ridge Community and Technical College.

The selection process will be made utilizing a 1000 word essay prepared by applicant on why the applicant desires a career in the electric utility industry, any special need considerations, and past meritorious accomplishments with most priority given to the following conditions in order of preference:

5. Other union member/dependent
6. Committee choice

Applications will be evaluated by UWUA Local 102 and Blue Ridge CTC faculty members of the EDET Advisory Council at Blue Ridge CTC.
